With this batch I was trying to graduate to not just making artwork but doing things with the artwork. What follows is an assortment of early attempts at using collage techniques to add depth, texture and in some cases, narrative.

The work begins with the Messi piece, showing chopped out, hovering elements and goes through heavy textured pieces before looping back around to saturated portraits which reuse the techniques in more subtle ways.

For most of this I used old pieces of artwork from my LFC match series but towards the end I started making new work, the Leroy Sane piece being a highlight.






































ABOUT DAN
